Participant Eligibility:

Participants must possess the following requirements to ensure successful completion of the program:

- Be at least 20 years of age at the time of enrollment in the Green Job Training Partnership Program;
- Possess a high school diploma or GED;
- Possess a valid driver's license or be able to obtain one prior to graduation from the program;
- Remain drug free throughout the entire program and submit to drug testing;
- Score a minimum of 7th grade level on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE).

LPCCD is recruiting 60 participants for its Green Job Training Program (GJTP). The program is designed to train workers for advancement and job security. Graduates will be placed into the following green job energy-efficiency occupations:

- Air Sealer
- Building Analyst
- Home Energy Rater
- Comprehensive Energy Auditor
- Weatherization Inspector
- Field Energy Consultant
- Energy Conservation Representative
- Home Improvement Retrofit Trainee
- Residential Air Sealing Technician
- Insulation Installer
- HVAC Maintenance/Repair Trainee

This five week program includes:

- Basic Literacy (Math and English)
- Life Skills and Job Readiness Skills
- OSHA Training
- Environmental Sustainability
- Financial Management
- Labor Unions 101
- Support Services
- Vocational Hard Skills Training
- Placement in 3-6 month internship with industry partners
